Pain Relief Foundation is pleased to announce **the Prof John Miles Prize PhD Studentship**, to enable a graduate to embark on a research career in human chronic pain.

Applications are invited from **Universities, Academic Institutes and other potential Project Supervisors** for this prestigious Studentship in human chronic pain research.

The grant award will be tenable for three years and will carry a **tax-free stipend up to £20,780 and tuition fees of £5,006 per annum**, there will be a small budget available to cover consumables. **There is no budget for equipment or overseas travel.**

The total grant is £85,000 over 3 years
(applications may be considered over 4 years but the funding will remain at £85k for the period)

Applications should include the Supervisor's C.V. and complete details of the proposed project. The application should name two academic referees.

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
