The closing date for receipt of applications is **13<sup>th</sup> February 2026**

We shall require the names and addresses of two **academic referees**, who will be prepared to support the project and the application.

These references will be taken up in the first instance after which the application will then be submitted for peer review.

When this process is complete, the applications will be placed before the Foundation's Scientific Advisory Sub-Committee for consideration after which, the Committee's recommendations will be submitted to the Foundation's Trustees.

It is expected that the final decision will be announced at the end of **June beginning July 2026**.
